ISSUE

The trainees had the opportunity to work on ac/dc motors, slip-rings and testing. During the week all aspects of motor strip and inspect, failure analyses and reporting as well as rebuild and test processes were covered. Practical assessments were also an essential part of the training programme.

The week passed quickly but the apprentices were able to return to site armed with a wealth of new knowledge and experience in workshop practices plus a hands-on experience in dealing with motor failures and repairs, including testing of machines to a standard that will improve the engineers' knowledge of ERIKS' products and services.
