

## **HONEYWELL 2000 SERIES – HOW TO FIT A SINGLE-USE MASK?**







- Open the respirator by pushing slightly on both sides
- Place the mask under the chin, the nose-bridge upward and outside
- Place the lower headband around the neck, below the ears
- Holding the mask against the face with one hand, place the top headband above the ears, around the crown of the head




**Check for leak-tightness as follows :** 

• place both hands over the mask and – exhale sharply for a mask without exhalation valve nhale deeply for a mask with exhalation valve

- if you feel air leaks around the edges, readjust the mask by tightening the nose-bridge and/or increasing tension of the headbands (by tying a knot)
- repeat the procedure until satisfactory face-fit has been achieved



#### WARNINGS:

- A beard may reduce the effectiveness of single-use masks
- The mask must be discarded after a single use (one shift maximum)
- A well fitted single-use mask guarantees efficient protection
