Case Study

ISSUE

After failing an internal financial audit, a client's stores were rated as Red status. Issues included poor storage of items, no stock movement history, no proper financial control, and numerous health and safety concerns.

SOLUTION

- An archive store was created for slow-moving, obsolete and second-hand parts
- New storage bins were installed for fast-moving parts and consumables
- A new and more efficient storeroom layout was designed and built
- Fast-moving parts and consumables from a separate electrical store were relocated to the main store
- A service counter and hatch were built for parts issuing
- Free-issue consumables were moved to the now empty electrical store
- New long-span racking was installed for larger items, and cantilevered racking for longer component parts and lengths of raw materials, to address health and safety issues
- Signage was installed for racks, shelves and bins to enable faster and more efficient location of parts

RESULTS

After completion of the project within the 16-week timescale, the stores were re-audited and their status ultimately raised to Green.

With product receipts and issues now being efficiently made, and the total inventory having been identified and accurately valued, rather than being a source of unwanted costs, the stores enabled potential cost, time and resource savings.











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
